Local Organization Aims To Reach All Eligible Families In Salt Lake And Tooele Counties.

SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH, February 3, 2005 — The Salt Lake CAP Head Start program is currently beginning its 2005-2006 recruitment drive. Their goal is to ensure that all families in the Salt Lake and Tooele counties who qualify for services have access to the Head Start program.

Head Start is a comprehensive preschool and family program. They provide an exceptional preschool education complimented by health and social services for the whole family. Program options include full and half-day classes; every child receives free meals while in Head Start. Head Start families benefit from access to a variety of community resources, diverse parent education programs including ESL and GED classes, and other social services to aid the family.

Eligible families are those whose total annual income does not exceed the federal poverty guidelines. The program is also able to provide services to families who do not qualify under the federal poverty guidelines but have a child with a special need. The non-discriminatory agency serves low-income families from all walks of life such as refugees and immigrants since 1964 and bi-lingual staff are available as needed.
